**HOUSING COORDINATOR, NYC VOLUNTEER GROUP HOUSING PROGRAM**

The Mission Continues empowers veterans facing the challenge of adjusting to life at home to find new missions. We redeploy veterans in their communities, so that their shared legacy will be one of action and service.*

**Duties include:**

- Collaborate with and support National VOAD and local nonprofits
- Train, supervise, and oversee SuperStorm Sandy rebuild volunteers on a rebuild site.
- Manage NYC VGHP host site reservation process.
- Identify resources and opportunities to assist volunteer host sites throughout NYC.
- Implement continuity plan and close-out VGHP at the end of Fellowship term.
- Assist with growing the capacity and maintaining continuity of the VGHP.
- Support staff in compiling regular statistical reports.
- Other duties as may be assigned by senior staff.

**Qualifications include:**

- Highly organized and detail oriented.
- Ability to effectively manage volunteers & host sites from many different faith and social groups.
- Experience in construction and volunteer management.
- Excellent computer skills: familiarity with Microsoft Office Suite, WordPress, Social Media, and Internet Applications.
- Ability and willingness to travel extensively throughout NYC.
- Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills, in person and on the phone.
- Positive energy and the ability to work collaboratively with a small staff.
- Multi-lingual candidates preferred.

**Fellowship requirement:**

- Must have served in the United States Armed Forces after September 11, 2001.
- Must have received an honorable discharge after a minimum of 24 months in military service (unless serious injury was sustained preventing further service).
- Must be able to lift 50 pounds and work effectively on an active construction site.

This is a 6-month Fellowship in partnership with The Mission Continues.  
Includes a cost-of-living stipend (plus cell phone, and MetroCard)
