Duties include:

- Support staff in managing NYDIS' Risk Communication platforms
- Develop strategies for increased social media engagement
- Update Twitter and Facebook feeds daily/regularly
- Retweet and repost relevant links from partner organizations and subject-matter experts
- Take the lead in writing and publishing monthly e-newsletters
- Collaborate with staff to obtain/post weekly direct service and events photographs
- Copy edit and proofread organizational grant reports, occasional special reports, and other documents as requested by supervisor and senior staff
- Duties may include some data entry

Qualifications include:

- Highly organized and detail oriented
- Interested in nonprofit communications
- Ability and willingness to work flexible hours (some evenings and weekends)
- Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills, in person and on the phone
- Positive energy and the ability to work collaboratively with a small staff
- Proficient in Microsoft Office, social media use, (with proof of active Social Media accounts)
- Ability to think critically and act independently
- Experience in faith-based organizations (preferred)
- A working knowledge of disaster response and recovery topics (preferred)

Age and education requirement:

- Must be 21 or older
- Candidates working towards a communication, emergency management or non-profit management degree are strongly encouraged to apply
- 2-3 years' experience of blogging/newsletter writing and/or use of social media platforms
