SUMMER INTERNSHIP (PAID), NYC VOLUNTEER GROUP HOUSING PROGRAM

NYDIS is a 501(c)(3) faith-based federation of faith communities, human services providers and charitable organizations who work in partnership to provide disaster readiness, response, and recovery services to New York City.

Duties include:

- Support volunteer groups and host congregations in the NYC Volunteer Group Housing Program
- In coordination with NYDIS staff, provide logistics support to arriving volunteer groups
- Support outreach efforts to recruit houses of worship and other potential new dorm sites
- Provide onsite assistance to “dorms” through training and/or operating resources
- Coordinate volunteer opportunities for unaffiliated volunteer groups
- Design and manage enrichment programs for volunteer groups
- Other duties as may be assigned by senior staff

Qualifications include:

- Highly organized and detail oriented
- Ability and willingness to travel extensively throughout New York City
- Ability and willingness to work flexible hours (some evenings and weekends)
- Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills, in person and on the phone
- Positive energy and the ability to work collaboratively with a small staff
- Computer skills - familiarity with Microsoft Office, Internet & Social Media use
- Experience in volunteer support and/or group housing preferred
- Familiarity with NYC faith communities and religious competency in housing settings
- A working knowledge of Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (VOAD) preferred

Age and education requirement:

- Must be 21 or older
- Undergraduate or graduate student/seminarian or a national service/volunteer corps alum
- 2-3 years minimum group leadership experience with congregation or volunteer groups

This is a 12-week summer internship.
