The Sandy Legal Representation Project at Lutheran Social Services of New York (LSSNY) is designed to provide free immigration legal services to survivors of Superstorm Sandy. Eligible individuals:

- Immigrants of any legal status who have been impacted by Superstorm Sandy.
- Includes individuals who are undocumented, and those with lawful status such as asylees, refugees, student visa-holders, green card-holders, temporary protected status, etc.)

Services offered:

LSSNY attorneys can provide legal consultations and advice, represent people in applications for legal status, help people replace lost immigration and identity documents, provide assistance with HRA when benefits have been improperly denied based on legal status, and in some cases represent individuals in immigration court. These services are for undocumented and documented immigrants alike - including permanent residents, asylees, students, and naturalized citizens. All services are free of charge!
