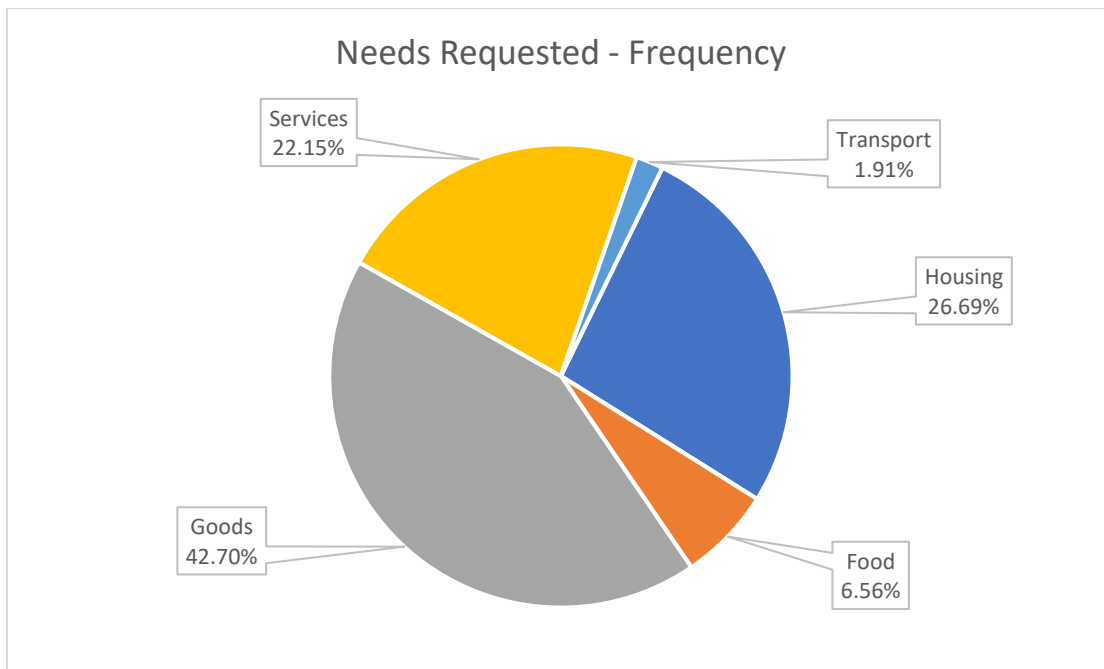

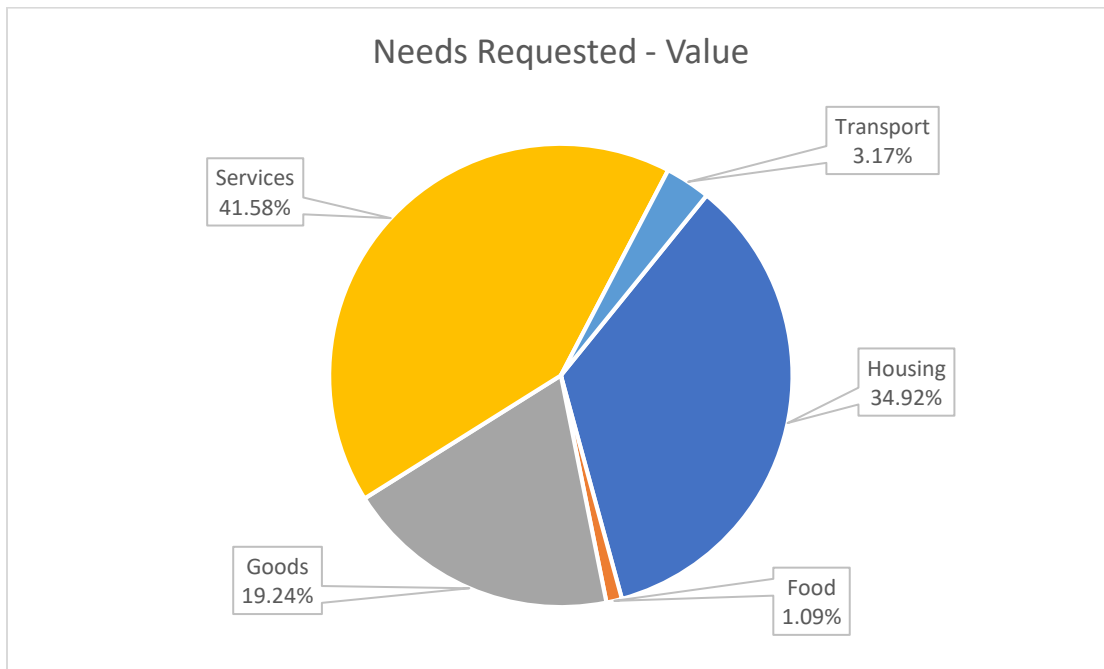

**Top 5 Unmet Needs Being Requested (By Value)**

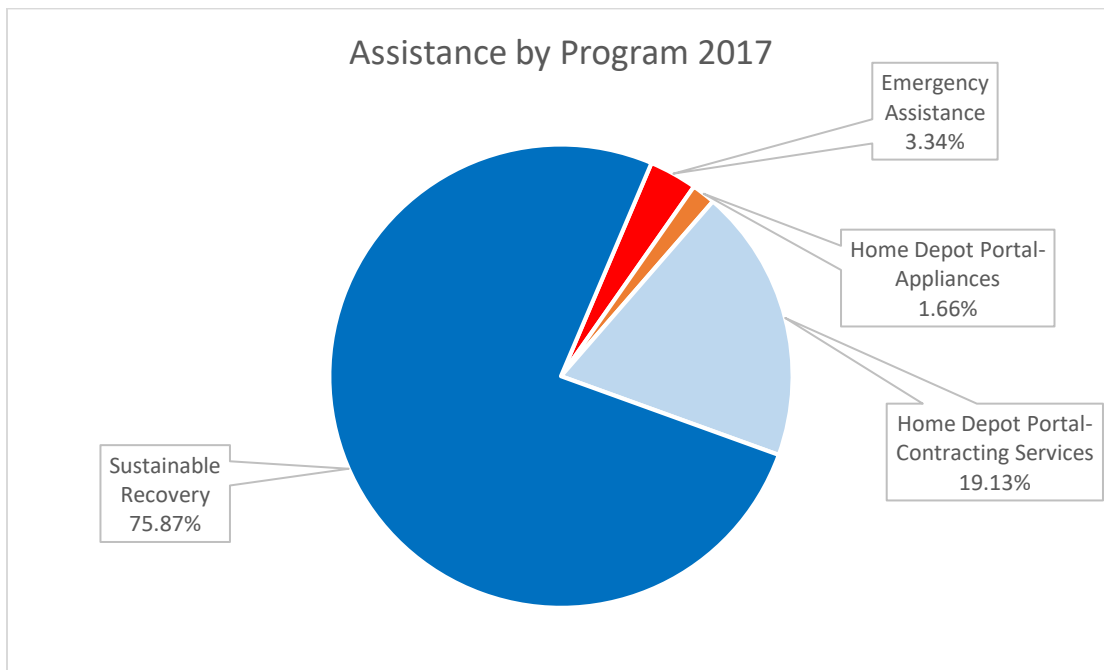

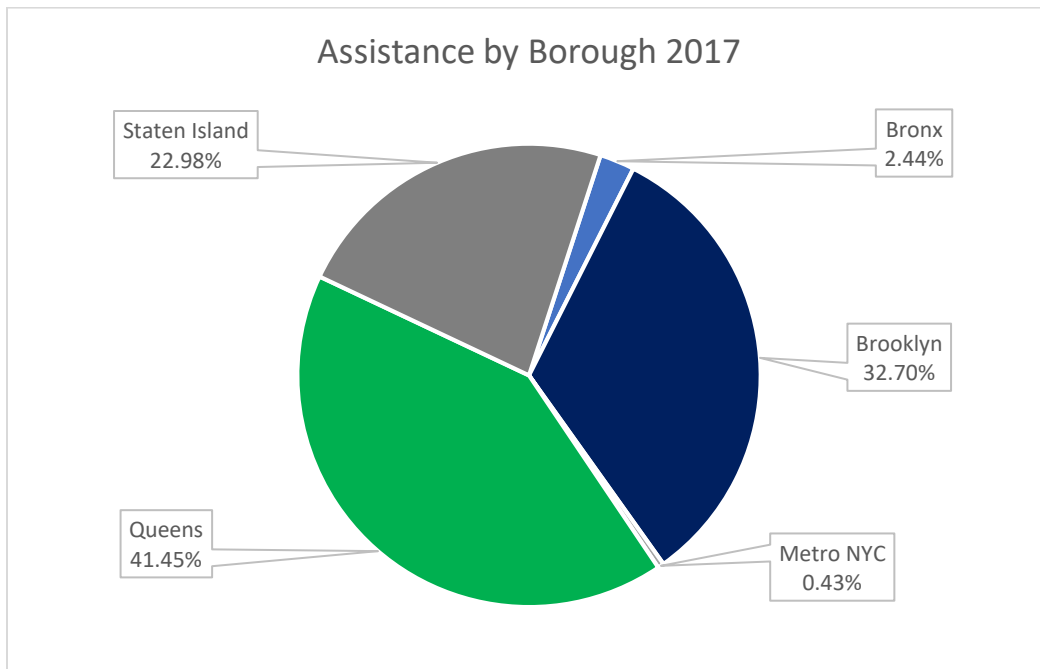

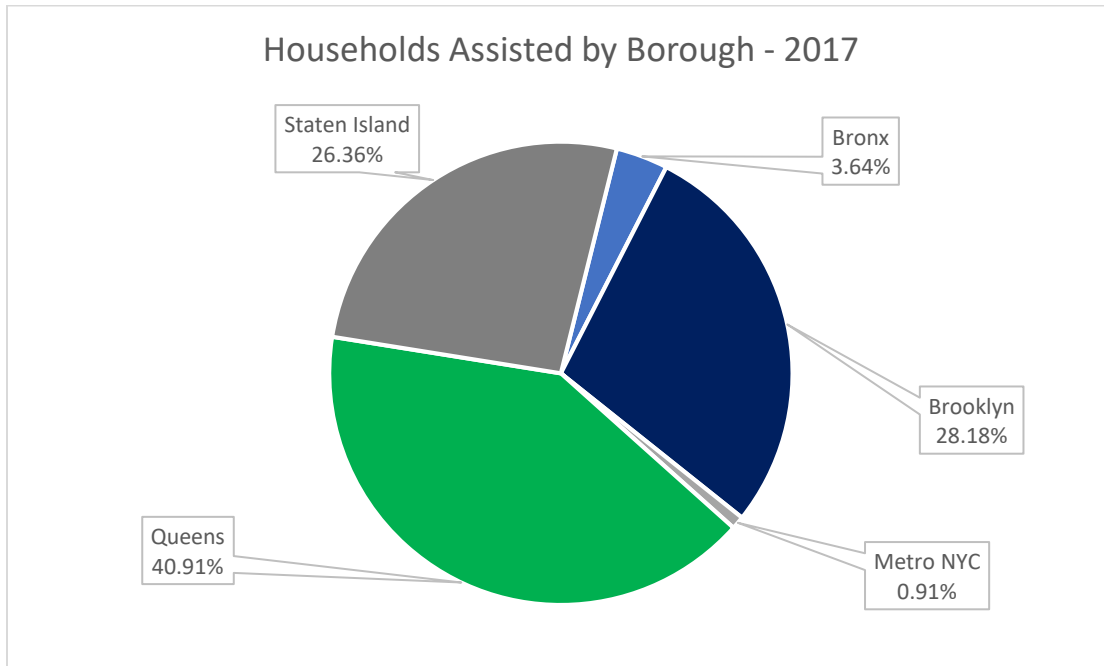

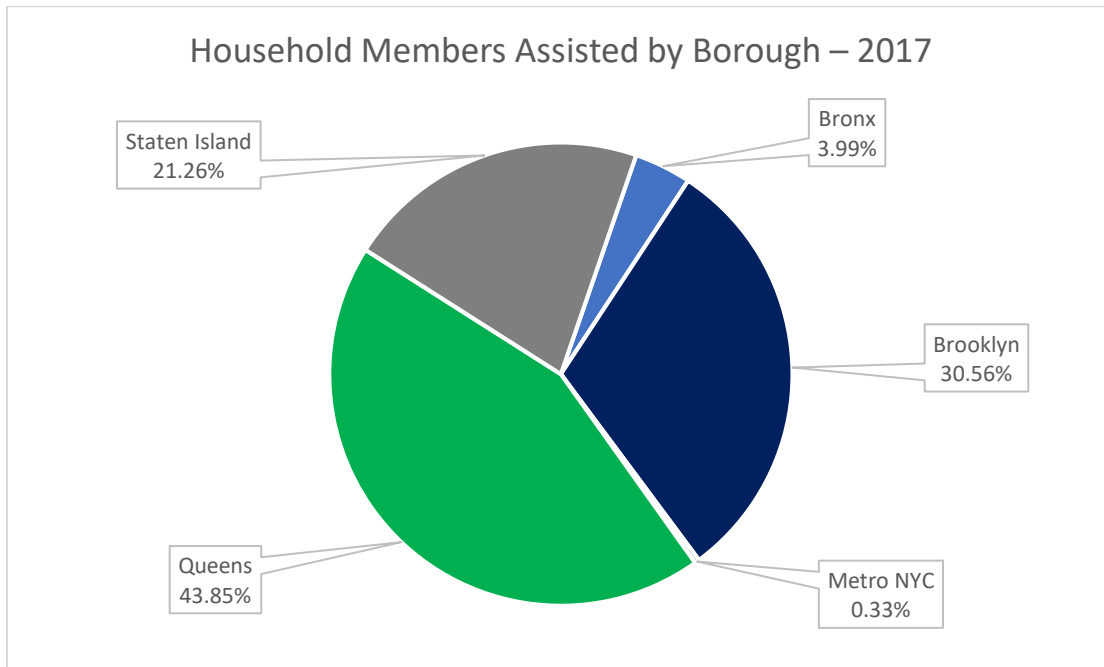

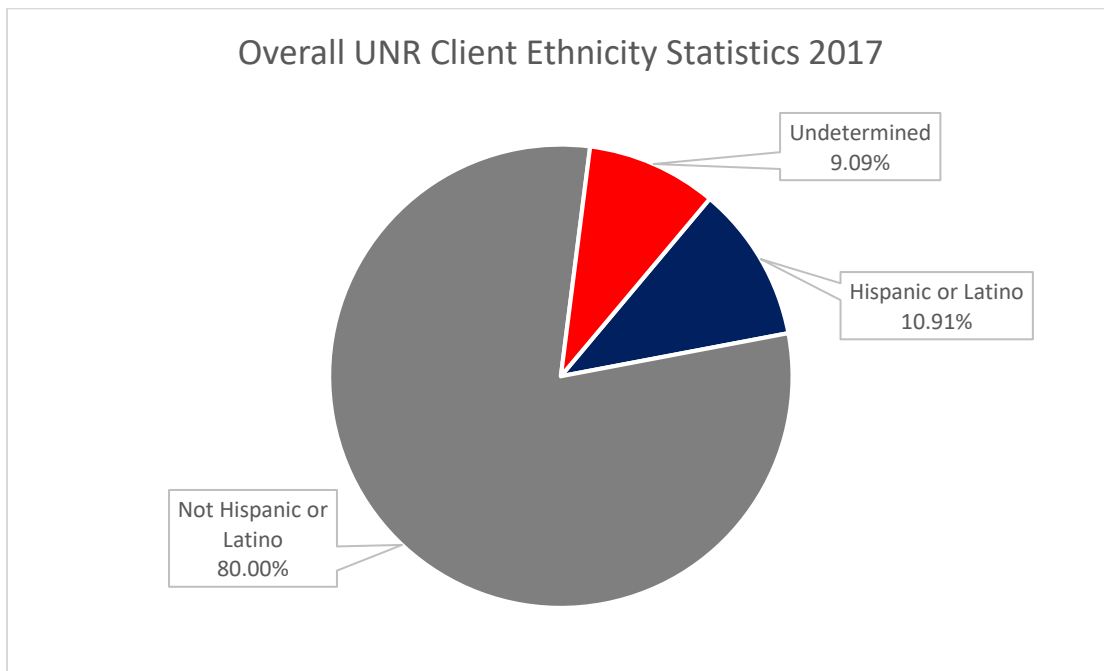
